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## Description

Recently set-up climbing crag in Nörsach, Nikolsdorf has around 50 routes in difficulty level III-X, predominantly V-VIII; rock: limestone; orientation: west-south-west; climb, around 2 minutes;

Difficulty: Von III bis X (Prevalent V-VIII)

Sealevel: 750 m

Orientation: S / W

Rock: Limestone

Sektoren/Routen: 1 / 53

Steepness: slightly inclined to slightly overhanging

Climbing: wallclimbing, mainly on edges

Belaying: well - bolts

Wall height: 5 – 25 m

In case of rain climbing is not possible!

Ideal period: march - november

Rock is drying quite rapidly

Way there: 5 min.
